

REQUIREMENTS

SVP Dashboard is a Microsoft Windows application. The following items are required to install and run the dashboard:

- 64-bit Microsoft Windows operating system: Microsoft Windows 7, or later
- current version of one of the following web browser:
 - Mozilla Firefox
 - Microsoft Edge
 - Google Chrome

You can get the SVP Dashboard installer from SunSpec Alliance with the file name:

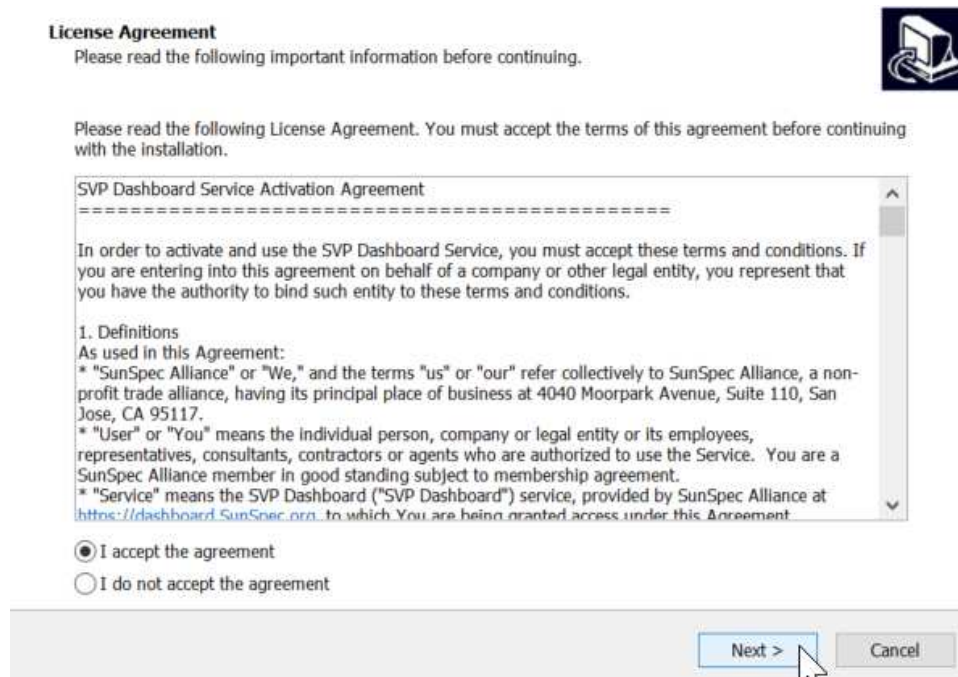
`svp_dashboard_setup_<version>.exe`

Save the file in a local directory.

INSTALL SVP DASHBOARD

These steps walk you through the SVP Dashboard installation.

1. Double-click the SVP Dashboard installer program to start the installation.
2. Accept the license agreement and click **Next**:



3. Select the checkbox if you want to create a desktop shortcut, and click **Next** to continue:

Select Additional Tasks

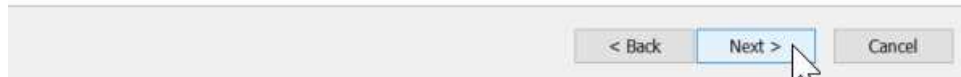

Select the additional tasks you would like Setup to perform while installing SVP Dashboard, then click Next.

4. Click **Install** to start the Windows installation:

Setup is now ready to begin installing SVP Dashboard on your computer.

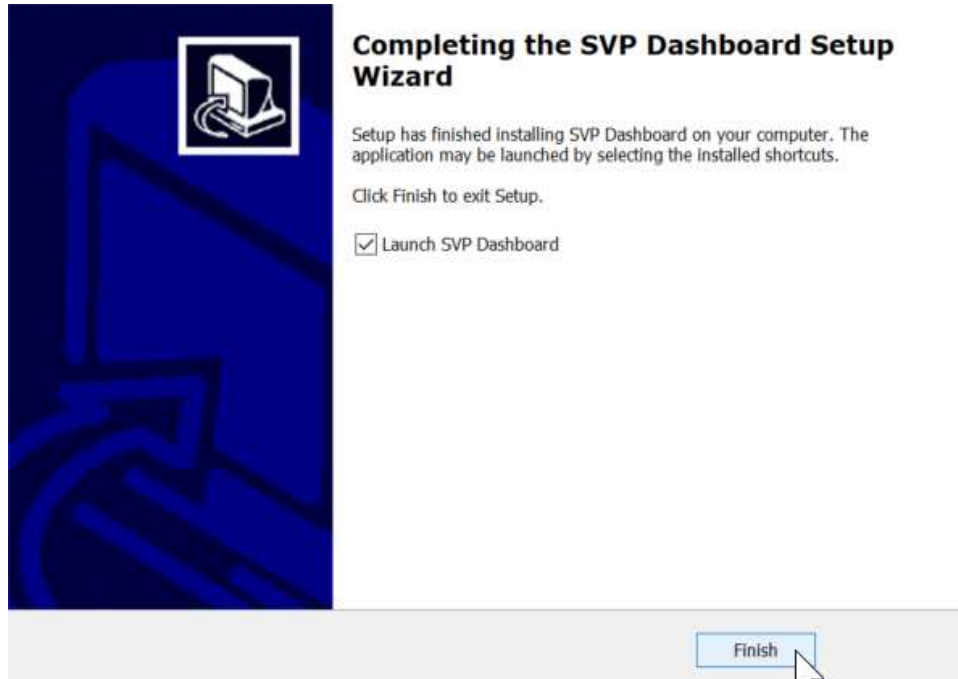


Click Install to continue with the installation, or click Back if you want to review or change any settings.



The installer displays a progress bar to indicate the installation status.

5. When installation completes, select the checkbox to run SVP Dashboard immediately. Click **Finish**:



LICENSE SVP DASHBOARD

Run the installed SVP Dashboard program to license your product instance.

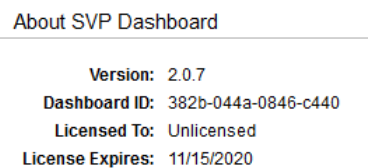
1. If you have not elected to automatically run the dashboard following installation, run SVP Dashboard either from the file manager by double-click the SVP Dashboard executable program, or by using the desktop shortcut. This displays the SVP Dashboard welcome page:



2. The dashboard graphical user interface (GUI) runs in the web browser served from localhost port 8444. Click the URL at the bottom of the page to access the SVP Dashboard GUI.
3. In the SVP Dashboard menu bar **Help** menu, select **About**:

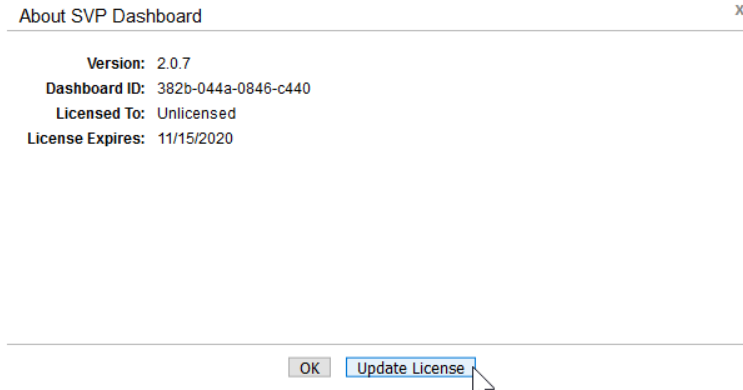


4. The **About SVP Dashboard** dialog displays version and licensing information:

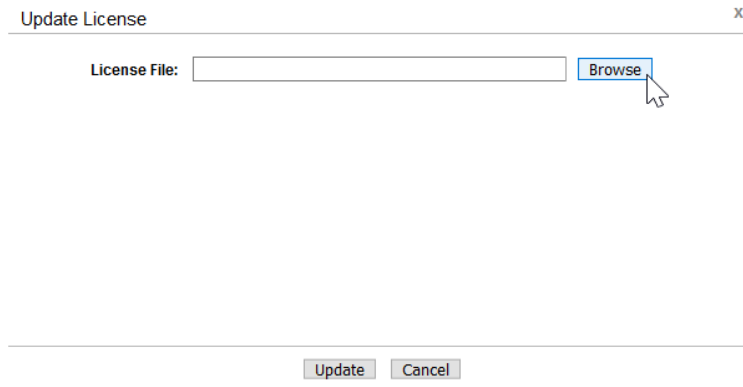


Record the **Dashboard ID**. You will need to provide this ID to Sunspec Alliance to get the license file.

5. Contact Sunspec Alliance to get the license file, providing the dashboard ID for your copy of SVP Dashboard.
6. After you download and save the license file, select **Update License** to begin the process of installing the license for your copy of SVP Dashboard:

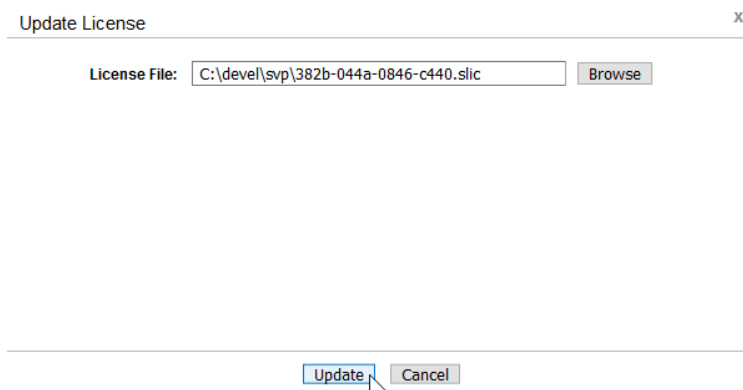


7. Select **Browse** and navigate to the location of the saved license file:



The license file name format is `xxxx-xxxx-xxxx-xxxx-.slic`.

8. Choose the file and select **Update** to install the license:



9. Click **OK** to complete license installation.

CLOSE SVP DASHBOARD

When you are done using the dashboard, completely end your SVP Dashboard session in two steps:

1. Close the SVP Dashboard browser tab or window.
2. Close the Windows program:
