Welcome to SunSpec's February alliance news round up. You will see major steps have been taken to solidify the SunSpec Certified™ program over the last month. To facilitate timely and cost effective product testing for IEEE 2030.5 / CSIP and SunSpec Rapid Shutdown, seven SunSpec Authorized Test Laboratories were welcomed to the SunSpec ecosystem.

Today, February 12, 2019, we announced the addition of Kyrlo as SunSpec's Official Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) Provider. Products that are SunSpec Certified for compliance with IEEE 2030.5 / CSIP will be authorized to use the SunSpec Official PKI to enable secure communications as required by California Rule 21.

To help explain what this development means for the industry, we will be hosting the SunSpec/Sandia Cybersecurity Workgroup meeting tomorrow (February 13) and will present additional background and details on the SunSpec PKI. We invite you to join us. You will also learn about our new Data-in-Flight initiative and paper entitled "Recommendations for Trust and Encryption in DER Interoperability Standards."

We look forward to engaging with you on this next phase of industry development.
